



EICA Graduation Requirements.

All these graduation paths include opportunities to take rigorous academic courses designed to prepare students for their future educational and career choices.

Regardless of graduation program, all students must earn a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale and complete 24 credits.

Once students complete their graduation requirements, we can issue a High School Diploma and transcripts. The student will need these documents as they progress in college or their career.

Our students must also remember that if they want to enter the Universities, they must take the standardized ACT or SAT exams and pass them with the score required by the University.
